COOL COAL MAN rated off the pace inside, angled three wide to pull to even terms at the five sixteenths pole, drew clear into the stretch, came in slightly a sixteenth out, then dug in and lasted. ELYSIUM FIELDS rated in good position three deep, drew to near even terms leaving the final turn, altered course outside a sixteenth out, then came again to be getting to the winner. COURT VISION, unhurried inside, started his drive angling seven wide toward the quarter pole and finished evenly in mid track. Z HUMOR showed no speed inside, bid nearing the final turn, was forced six wide leaving the quarter pole and proved empty in the stretch. GOLDEN SPIKES rated a short lead inside, contested a slight disadvantage through the final turn then weakened into the stretch. HALO NAJIB showed no speed off the rail, bid mildly inside entering the stretch and finished evenly toward the rail. KENTUCKY BEAR rated off the pace and off the rail, entered the stretch four wide and weakened from there. ANAK NAKAL, unhurried off the rail, showed no response toward the outside on the final turn. ADRIANO steadied into the first turn and never factored. READY SET steadied between horses into the opening turn, settled back four deep, picked up the chase into the final turn but weakened through the lane. MAKE THE POINT stalked the early pace two deep, was pressured to a slim brief lead into the final turn but gave way off the rail entering the stretch. MONBA was squeezed into the opening turn and not a factor after. Due to teletimer malfunction, race was hand timed.
